Grow Hope Niagara Report - Contributions to Canadian Food Grains Bank/Mennonite Central Committee through the Grow Hope project in Niagara last year amounted to over \$36,000. Tom Neufeld reports that it was a challenging year for all farmers last spring to get any crop into the fields. A buckwheat crop ended up as a useful late experiment for the season. Thanks to Larry and Marge Dyck and family for handling the pressures of farming that crop. The Mennonite constituency expresses gratitude to them. Tom left on January 23rd on an MCC study tour to Ethiopia to visit development projects there that are connected to CFGB work with conservation agriculture education, where MCC has had a strong role to play. On March 29th, Tom will share about his trip here at Grace to provide a contemporary view of what some of our donation dollars are achieving. More details to be provided.
